Ingredients

Cream 2 eggs and 2 cups sugar.

1/3 lb butter (10 ½ T)

1/6 lb margarine (5 T)

2/3 tsp vanilla

Pinch of salt

1/3 cup water

1 1/3 tsp baking powder



Instructions

Add flour to make dough handleable.

Chill overnight.

Roll out and cut into desired shapes.

Bake at 375°F for 6-10 minutes, or until edges turn golden brown.
